BRIEF DESCRIPTION

Dogs Of Chinatown combines a hyperreality look with the martial arts action of Hong Kong cinema, all set in a world filled with gangsters, strippers and assassins.

SYNOPSIS

Jack saves the girl and finds out she is the mistress of a Triad boss. Impressed by Jack's actions, the Triad makes him one of their own and grooms him to be their top assassin. But as the hard-boiled killer rises to the top, he falls for Boss Wu's favorite mistress, Jin, putting both their lives at risk. As Jack battles his way through the Mafia and the Triad, he must decide if his loyalty is with the Boss who gave him a new life, or the girl he loves.

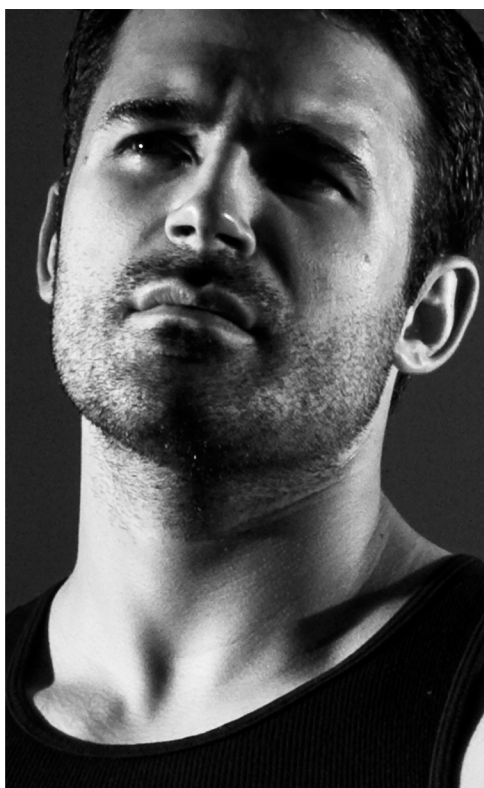

**Eric Jacobus**

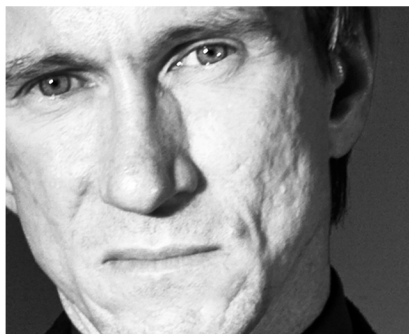
Actor (Jack), Action Choreographer
